Tasting Notes

Color: Intense ruby red.

Aroma: Red and black fruits, interlaced with coffee, chocolate, caramel and spicy notes.

Flavour: On the palate is elegant, well structured and has a pleasant finish.

Vinification Process

The wine goes through a pre-fermentative cold maceration for 4 days. It is then fermented at temperatures of 26° - 30°C. When fermentation has finished, the wine is aged in 1st and 2nd French and American oak barrels for 14 months.
